General Rules - APA 6th Edition Citation Examples ...

Examples: "Sometimes I feel quite CERTAIN there's a JERTAIN in the CURTAIN" (Seuss, 1974, p. 4). "The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dog" (Seuss, 2007, pp. 7-8). If you use more than one work by the same author, use the letters a, b, etc., after the year.

APA 6th Ed: In-Text Citations - Citation Resources ...

Example: Keats (1962) wrote about a child's experiences with the snow. Another way to document the source is to use parenthetical citation. In this case, all information about the source will be located in the parentheses at the end of the sentence, before the punctuation.

Tips: When citing sources that you find on the Internet you only need to include a retrieval date if the information you viewed is likely to change over time (p. 192).
