Feeding Times - The toddler room will have a specific feeding/snack time. NO sippy cups in the toddler class. The nursery will have specific information on each child's feeding times. Nursery Classroom Schedule- Nursery classroom will use blocks, rings baby gyms, pillows to lean on or sit up on.

The following health guidelines are widely held as standard procedure for daycare facilities, and are intended to aid parents and nursery workers in determining whether or not a child can be accepted in the nursery for care. Temperature - A temperature of 100 degrees or below with NO OTHER SYMPTOMS is acceptable.

### Nursery Policies — Holmen Baptist Church

Nursery Guidelines No one should be in the nursery except the nursery workers and the children being brought to the nursery for care. Ages for the nursery are birth through 3 years of age and should not be in the nursery without a nursery worker present. The nursery is not to be used as a playroom for older children at any time.

### Nursery — Pine Island Baptist Church

Many church insurance policies now require that churches adopt the "two-person" rule. One adult should never be alone with a child or in a classroom, and, under no circumstances, is a child to be left in a classroom or anywhere unattended. This protects children from abuse, and it protects our children's ministry volunteers from accusation.
