7,700 years ago, Mount Mazama located in Oregon's volcanic Cascades, exploded. It sent ash as far as northwest Yellowstone National Park, British Columbia and central Nevada. 150 times more ash than the 1980 eruption of Mount St. Helens. The resulting caldera eventually filled with water and is now part of Crater Lake National Park.
