Home Health Aide salary. As per the Bureau of Labor Statistics, in 2015 the average hourly wage of a HHA was \$11.00 and the average annual wage was \$22,870. Approximately 820,630 individuals were employed as HHAs in 2015 and the top 10% of the employees earned \$29,950 / year.
