Traditional forms of verse use established rhythmic patterns called meters (meter means "measure" in Greek), and that's what meters are — premeasured patterns of stressed and unstressed syllables.. Much of English poetry is written in lines that string together one or more feet (individual rhythmical units). Feet are the individual building blocks of meter.

Meter refers to the rhythm of a poem. This isn't the same as rhyme, even though the words have the same root. Rhythm refers to the sound of each line of poetry, not just the last sound, and meter is a way of counting or identifying the system of rhythm used.

Words That Rhyme With Practical

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Poets who rhyme in trochaic verse often drop the final unaccented syllable from the line. This procedure is called "catalexis" (a word related to the Greek katalektikos, "incomplete"), and it spares the poet the necessity of using disyllabic rhymes, which tend to jingle.Stopping at the seventh position, that is, allows the poet to rhyme securely on a single metrically accented syllable.

Timothy Steele - Introduction to Meter

The meters are iambs, trochees, spondees, anapests and dactyls. In this document the stressed syllables are marked in boldface type rather than the tradition al "/" and "x." Each unit of rhythm is called a "foot" of poetry. The meters with two-syllable feet are IAMBIC (x /) : That time of year thou mayst in me behold

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
