Open Textbook Quality Criteria Criterion 1: Scope and Sequence. 1.1: Textbook contains a comprehensive standard scope and sequence for a particular college course or set of courses. 1.2: Textbook is easily divisible into smaller sections, with text that is not overly self-referential in order to enable modularity as much as possible.
